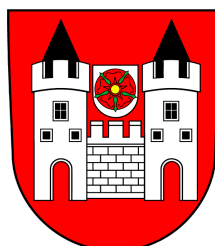

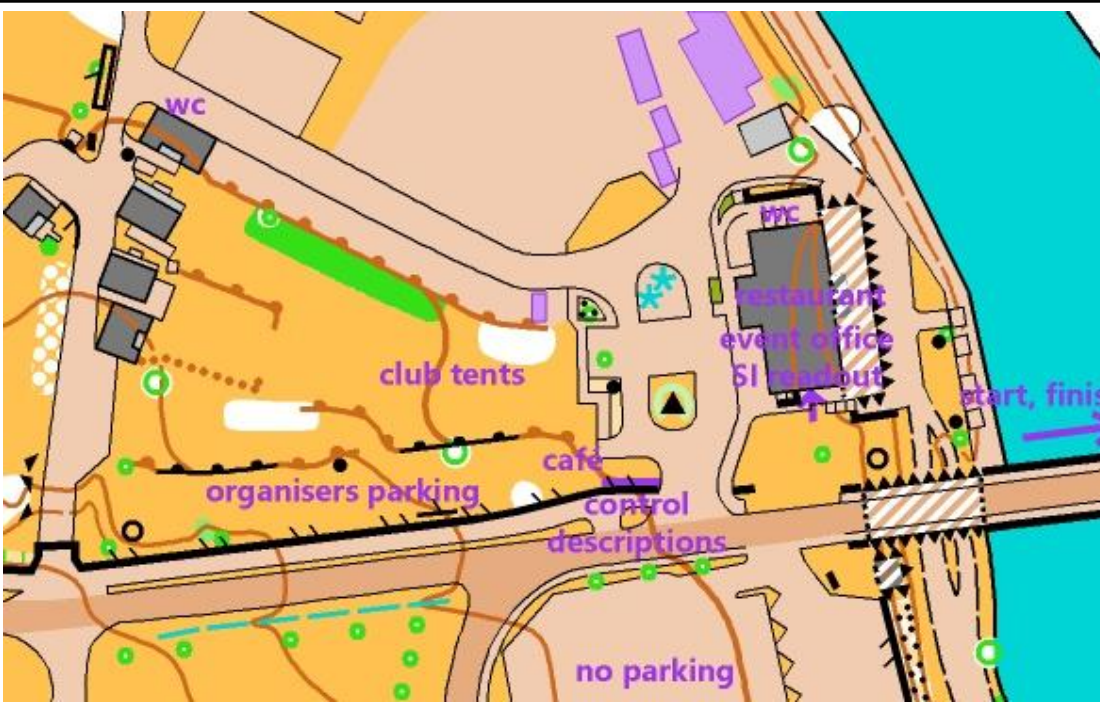

Location, Event center:	Vyšší Brod, Paddlers'camp, GPS 48.6236N, 14.3064E
Organizing body:	South Bohemian Regional Association of the Czech Orienteering Federation

Parking:	Please park only in the designated parking area for competitors. No parking fee will be charged. The route to the event center is marked with green and white ribbons. https://mapy.com/s/nebuzejave



Event office:

On the day of the race, registration will take place from 12:30 to 13:30 at the event center. Only one representative per club should handle the registration, and only if changes are necessary. Proof of entry fee payment can be downloaded from ORIS. Upon request, we can also send it via email. Changing the SI card number or name within the same category and club is free of charge. Other changes will be treated as late entries.

Event center map		
Distances:	1,000 m 2,000 m/climb 110m 1,500 m	parking – event center (marked with green and white ribbons) event center – start. The route to the start passes near the finish. The turn-off to the finish is after 1,300 m; the finish is 250 m from this point. It will be possible to leave clothing at the finish. The route is marked with blue and white ribbons and partly follows a class III road – please be careful. finish – event center (marked with red ribbons)
Terrain:	Hilly terrain at the foot of the mountains, with rough running surfaces and a sparse, irregular network of paths. There are many boulders and rocks of different sizes, and in some parts of the forest, thick bushes and overgrown clearings make running more difficult.	
Start procedure:	Interval start 00= 14:00 Categories T, P, HDR, F – free start from time 00 until the last competitor, using a separate corridor according to the instructions of the start official. Linz Cup categories will start from time 60. There will be the usual 3 start corridors for interval-start competitors: • The first corridor contains the CLEAR control, • The second corridor contains the CHECK control, • The third corridor contains the SIAC Test control. Maps will be placed in the last corridor. Competitors line up next to their map and may pick it up only after the start signal. The map start is located 80 meters from the start along red-and-white ribbons and is marked with a control flag. Water will be available near the start.	
Map:	1:10,000, e: 5 m, status as of 06/2025, A4 format, waterproof-treated (PRETEX) for categories D16, D18, D20, D21, H16, H18, H20, H21, HA, M21E, W21E. For other classes, a scale of 1:7,500 will be used.	
Punching system:	The SportIdent system (hereinafter referred to as SI) will be used. Controls will be set up for contactless punching. In case of malfunction, please use the backup mechanical punching. Each competitor is required to reset and check their SI chip before the start and to have their SI chip data downloaded to the computer as soon as possible after finishing the race (even if they do not complete the race!). In case of SI unit failure, the competitor must use mechanical punching with pliers in the "R" boxes on the map and is required to immediately inform the finish referee upon arrival. Competitors without their own chip may rent one from the organizer for the stated fee.	
SI Card Rental:	Standard SI cards (contact punching) will be available for rent for a fee of 50 CZK. In case of loss, a fee of 800 CZK will be charged. If needed (e.g. you forget your own card, have a dead battery, or want to try contactless punching), SIAC cards (contactless) will also be available for rent for 50 CZK. In case of loss, a fee of 1,900 CZK will be charged.	
Start list:	Will be posted at the event center and at the start.	

Control Descriptions:	Will be available for self-service pickup at the event center and also printed on the map. A Battery Test control will be located next to the control descriptions at the event center.
Competition area:	The forest area of Kraví hory, bordered by the villages of Hrudkov, Lachovice, and the town of Vyšší Brod.
Finish and SI Card Read-out:	The competitor finishes the race by punching the finish control. SI card download will take place at the event center. Maps are not collected at the finish. Please observe the principles of fair play.
Finish closing time:	After the time limit for the last starting competitor expires, approximately at 17:30.
Time limit:	90 minutes for all categories.
Timing accuracy:	To whole seconds.

Results Ceremony:	At the event center, approximately at 17:00. In categories DH10–DH21, WM21E, the first three competitors will be announced and awarded diplomas and small prizes. In categories HDR, DF, HF, all participants will be rewarded. In other categories, winners will be announced, except for the Linz Cup categories, where competitors will receive diplomas.
Terrain Details:	Hilly foothill terrain with challenging running surface and a sparse, irregular network of paths. A large number of boulders and rocks of various sizes; in some forest parts, thick undergrowth and overgrown clearings reduce runnability. Be careful of old fallen fences. Noticeable old fences in the terrain are marked on the map.
Map Details:	Scale 1:10,000, Hrudkov, contour interval 5 m, updated 06/2025, waterproof (PRETEX) for categories D16, D18, D20, D21, H16, H18, H20, H21, HA, M21E, W21E. For other categories, a scale of 1:7,500, Hrudkov 7.5, contour interval 5 m will be used.
Special map symbols:	○ shelter □ well, manhole ✕ root stock △ terrace

First aid:	First aid will be provided at the finish.			
Refreshments:	Water will be available before the start and after finishing at the finish area. A restaurant is located in the facilities of the Canoeing Camp at the event center.			
WC:	In the facilities of the Canoeing Camp at the event center, see the event center map.

Protests:	Written protests must be submitted to the event controller along with a deposit of 400 CZK during the event. If the protest is upheld, the deposit will be refunded. Any protests regarding the start list or final results can be submitted via email at info@tjobcb.cz .			
GDPR regulation:	By registering for this event, each participant agrees to the publication of their personal data in the valid COF format, including their registration form, start list, and results on the event website and in the ORIS information system. During the event, press photographs will be taken to inform the public about the race, to account for event funding, etc., in accordance with § 89 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code. Additionally, photographs may be taken for the personal use of competitors (as a memento of the race, for promoting your orienteering club), especially during the award ceremony and finish. If you do not agree to be photographed, please inform the photographer explicitly.			
Attention:	All competitors start at their own risk and are responsible for any damage they cause. Legal guardians are responsible for underage participants. Commercial or promotional activities are permitted only with the consent of the event director.			
Regulations:	The competition will be held according to the valid Orienteering Rules, the Competition Rules, and the Implementing Regulations of the South Bohemian Regional Association of COF for the year 2025.
